Dear Colleague:

The California State Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) Pharmacy Services has entered an exciting time in which pharmaceutical care is being reengineered to reach the state-of-the-art for organized health-system pharmacy. In conjunction with Maxor National Pharmacy Services, the latest technology and management systems are being implemented to allow state-wide access to patient prescription information, provide an electronic real-time inventory and electronic medication administration records, and make universal bar coding the basis of medication safety processes both in pharmacy and at the point of care. This new model will incorporate the use of an automated central pharmacy to provide drug distribution support allowing facility level pharmacists to engage in clinical patient care as part of the multidisciplinary team. We need the help of a talented and enthusiastic work force to accomplish our project goals. (17)

This work takes place in the context of a momentous effort to improve prison medical care and bring it up to constitutional standards. U.S. District Court Judge Thelton E. Henderson has appointed Receiver Robert Sillen to direct the changes to medical care in California's 33 adult prisons. Improving the pharmacy system is a top priority of the Receivership. It will be accomplished working together with Maxor, CDCR staff and new recruits such as you.

There are 33 institutions statewide to choose from and we offer an excellent working environment. If you are a Pharmacist, then you, too, can join our dedicated team of professionals. We want to share with you the many opportunities and wonderful benefits that are available today.

Salaries for facility level pharmacists range between \$107,000 and \$112,000 per year while Pharmacists In Charge can earn between \$118,000 and \$124,000 per year. A rewarding civil service benefits package is included raising the effective value of the monthly compensation by approximately 31%, to between \$137,000 and more than \$155,000. In addition, retirement benefits are calculated using a member's years of service, age at retirement, and final compensation averaged for a defined period of employment, rather than from contributions and earnings to a savings plan. State employees are also eligible to participate in the Deferred Compensation Program by deferring up to \$2,500 per month pre-tax to 401 and 457 plans. This type of benefit package is not available to most other members of the workforce.
